Lent 2019 will begin on Wednesday, March 6th
And ends on Thursday, April 18th

What is Lent? Lent is the annual period of Christian observance that precedes Easter. Lent starts on Ash Wednesday and its observance lasts for 40 days, mirroring the 40 days that Jesus spent fasting in the wilderness before starting his ministry.

Lent is a penitential period, involving the dual disciplines of abstinence and fasting. During Lent many Christians commit to fasting or giving up certain foods, habits or luxuries- for example meat, cakes and sweets, alcohol, smoking - for its duration (the money saved is often then donated to charity). This is done both as a form of penitence and as a spiritual tool to tame the body and 'sharpen the spirit' for prayer, reflection and contemplation in preparation for the celebration of Easter.

Application During this Lent Season, we want to encourage "prayer for one another." Use the tear off or drop a small note in the offering plate with a name for prayer. We will encourage members to stop by the Receptionist Desk and pick up a name to pray for others during the entire Lenten Season.
